- 1. Read Acts 10:34-43.
- 2. Throughout chapter 10, and as he retells the story in chapter 11, Peter is taught about the inclusiveness of God. Verse 34 is the time when Peter declares his understanding of God's message to him. What does this say to you?
- 3. How does Peter tell the story of Jesus to Cornelius and his family? How is this different from the gospel story he tells in Acts 2, to that group of people?
- 4. How does he tell them differently?
- 5. How does this passage mark a change in God's direction for the church?
- 6. What implications from this do you draw?
- 7. Doug stated that this past chapter 10 is the true "meat" of the passage. How is that so?
- 8. How do you tell the story of Jesus to others around you?
- 9. In this passage of scripture, the church became much more multicultural than previously. How can we continue that mission here in Creswell?
