2. Why were the followers of Jesus called “the Way?” verse 2
3. Why Damascus? Where was it? What was it? About how many synagogues were in Damascus?
4. Why were the letters he procured from the high priest addressed to the synagogues in Damascus? Where did the followers of Jesus Christ worship?
5. Discuss Paul’s encounter on the road. What happened?
6. Read Acts 22:1-21 and Acts 26:1-18. Discuss variations of the story. What do you take from these different renditions of the event?
7. Do you find any evidence that Jesus had attempted to call Saul previously?
8. Imagine that you are Ananias. What would you have felt as you received the instruction to go talk to Saul?
9. What was Saul’s purpose in life?
10. Do you have a specific purpose for your life?
